



Registration Checklist

This document covers some of what you will need at Registration to complete your eligibility to compete. It does not include any boat measurement requirement - that will be covered in a separate email from Mark Robinson.

We expect that most northern hemisphere memberships apply for calendar years, so may need renewal for January. We have the same issue when AUS boats travel north as our sailing associations start with our season in October. Hence we must ask these questions and request you ensure you comply with ISAF and IMCA rules and the NOR.

1. Is your IMCA membership up to date for January 2015? Do you need to renew with your National IMCA association before leaving home? If so contact your National Secretary and get him to advise us who is financial for the regatta. Can you provide proof of membership at registration? Or will you be joining IMCA as an individual member? (because you have no national association.) If so contact IMCA Secretary Rayshelle Martin rayadmartin@hotmail.com or Treasurer Martin Gravare martin@gravare.com as soon as possible - they do not want a queue at registration.

2. Is your National Authority/Club Membership up to date for January 2015? Do you need to renew it before leaving home? Do you have proof of membership to present to registration?

3. Is your boat covered by the Third Party Insurance required by the NOR? Do you have proof of coverage documents to present at registration?

4. Can you scan these documents and email them to myself or Peter Osbourne at SSCBC peter.osbourne@tpg.com.au

This will speed up the registration process and possibly get you sailing as quickly as you wish.
